

CWA CAMPAIGN TO **KEEP TRAFFIC IN NYPD** GAINS STRENGTH



CWA is ratcheting up its campaign to make sure the city budget does not move Traffic out of the NYPD.

The members of CWA Local 1182 are the key to making this campaign a success. And **you** are getting it done:

- ✓ Over the last week, we have made hundreds of phone calls to the offices of key City Council leaders. You have let them know that Traffic must stay in NYPD.
- ✓ As of today, over one thousand members have signed a petition that will be delivered to City Council Speaker Corey Johnson and Mayor Bill de Blasio urging them to keep Traffic in the NYPD.
- ✓ Thanks to CWA's strong outreach efforts, the Transportation Alternatives advocacy group has backed off any proposal that TEAs should be removed from the NYPD. Their current proposals to reform traffic regulations do not affect TEAs and Supervisors at all.
